SCROLL SAWING AND IMITATION WOOD CARVING.

The art of Wood Carving cannot be too strongly recommended to all who delight in works of art, especially to my friends, the amateur Scroll Sawyers and all those who desire by their own skill and industry to beautify their homes. Being only a plain practical man and no writer, I will try to the best of my ability to make, in

few and plain words such explanations as according to my idea are needed. We begin with imitation wood carving first, this being the easiest and improve as we go ahead. Here we have a little design of a church, it looks as if it was all carved with carving tools, but what was it made with? A bracket saw frame, knife, a few punches, one carving tool for the corner moulding and a three-corred file. Cut up the plain parts of wood as on the pattern, then get a No. 1 punch and hammer it all over the face. No. 4 punch is good for the edges and No. 6 for roofs. They are



sold for 25 cents each. State number, when ordering. To make the mouldings, cut † strips and file them like this, one stroke with the file is enough. Then get a No. 3



carving tool and cut ridges in like this. There is no need of them being very regular, but a very handsome moulding for most any of these carved articles (see other side) is thus produced.



The base should be punched outside of the steps and as far as the side towers go and a No. 2 and 3 punch will look well, if made like this. constitution
